On 19.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail
in FIR No.45, dated 15.06.2019, registered under
Sections 326/324/323/506/34 IPC at Police Station
Airport, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that it is a case of version and cross version and the
petitioner also suffered injury on the head which was
declared to be grievous in nature. She further submits that
there is a delay of 7 days in registration of the FIR and
dispute between the parties, even as per the FIR, is with
regard to division of the family property. She further
submits that initially when the Investigating Officer
visited first informant/injured, he refused to give
statement on the ground that there are talks of settlement

between the parties.

Notice of motion for 15.10.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. SPS Tinna, Addl. A.G.,Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. SPS Tinna, Addl. A.G.,Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Salwinder Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 19.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
