Short reply by way of an affidavit filed in Court is taken on record.

This is an application praying for emergency parole on the ground that the father of the petitioner, namely, Joginder Singh has died on 09.08.2019 and his Bhog (*tervi*) ceremony is fixed for 21.08.2019. He is undergoing life imprisonment upon conviction under Section 364-A of the IPC vide judgment of conviction dated 04.12.2009 and order of sentence dated 07.12.2009 passed by the Sessions Judge, Kaithal.

Having heard Mr. Majra and Mr. Mohunta, I deem it appropriate that the petitioner is entitled to be granted emergency parole to attend the Bhog ceremony of his father. Accordingly, the petitioner is granted three days emergency parole on furnishing adequate surety to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, concerned. The respondents are directed to release the petitioner at about 4.00 PM on 20.08.2019 and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 23.08.2019 before 4.00 PM.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
