Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and waives service on them.

This is an application praying for emergency parole on the ground that the elder brother of the petitioner, namely, Satish has died and his Bhog ceremony is fixed for 18.08.2019. The petitioner was one of two brothers. He is undergoing seven years sentence upon conviction under Section 398 IPC and under Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act vide judgment dated 27.11.2018 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak.

Having heard Mr. Sidhu and Mr. Mohunta, I deem it appropriate that the petitioner is entitled to be granted emergency parole to attend the Bhog ceremony of his brother. Accordingly, the petitioner is granted three days emergency parole on furnishing adequate surety to the satisfaction of District Magistrate concerned. The respondents are directed to release the petitioner at about 4.00 PM today itself and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 20.08.2019 before 4.00

Petition is accordingly allowed.
