Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.104 dated 09.07.2019 under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, not only challan in the case has been presented, rather the petitioner has been admitted on regular bail by the trial Court. Even the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the fact that challan in the case has been presented and the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.08.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court unless her personal appearance is exempted.
