Pursuant to the order dated 19.08.2019, the affidavits of Shri Deepak Hilori, SSP, Pathankot and Shri Raminder Singh, DSP, Special Branch, Pathankot, have been filed in court today by learned State counsel, with copies given to learned counsel for the petitioners. Consequently, the affidavits are taken on record.

It has been stated in the affidavits that the e-mail making the allegations against the petitioners was found to have been “falsely generated”, and has not sent by the person it was purported to be sent by, i.e. one Ajay Kapoor, and that the petitioners in fact had never been called for investigation.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not press this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
