By this order we will dispose of eleven civil writ petitions bearing CWP Nos.24495, 25835, 25836, 28203, 30019, 31220, 32914 of 2018, 8223, 8255, 8337 and 9146 of 2019.

On 13.3.2019, we had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that this issue is squarely covered by the ratio of judgment of this Court in CWP No.1772 of 2018 titled as M/s Sangam Infra Estate Pvt. Ltd. Vs. State of Haryana & others, decided on 30.11.2018. This fact is not disputed by the respondents-State but it is stated that SLP has been preferred against the said judgment. Be that as it may, the

only relief that we have granted in Ms. Sangam Infra Estate Pvt. Ltd.(supra) case is a reconsideration by the State which ordinarily would leave the field open for them (the State) to take a decision on the issues raised in the petition.

Since learned counsel for the respondents states that he would like to examine this aspect, therefore, on his request, adjourned to 28.03.2019.”

The only plea taken by the respondents in not passing an order is that SLP has been preferred against the decision rendered by this Court in CWP no. 1772 of 2018 titled as **M/s Sangam Infra Estate Pvt. Ltd. vs. State of Haryana and others'** decided on 30.11.2018.

To our minds, this may not be a satisfactory response, particularly, when it is conceded that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the ratio of judgment rendered in M/s Sangam Infra Estate Pvt. Ltd. (supra). Hence, instant petitions are disposed of in same terms as in CWP no. 1772 of 2018 titled as **M/s Sangam Infra Estate Pvt. Ltd. vs. State of Haryana and others'** decided on 30.11.2018.
