Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.96 dated 14.06.2019 under Sections 326, 324, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Vide order dated August 30, 2019, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant thereto, a report has been received from the Mediator that the matter has been compromised between the parties and settlement/agreement dated 13.11.2019 has been reduced into writing.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that respondent

No.2 has joined the matrimonial home and is staying with the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation Centre vide settlement/agreement dated 13.11.2019, the present petition is allowed and the order dated August 30, 2019, whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to him.
