Judgement dated 23.05.2013 is taken on record.

C.W.P. No.24524 of 2018

Vide order dated 06.03.2002 (Annexure P-1) passed by Assistant Collector Grade I, Hoshiarpur, the mutation was sanctioned in favour of the respondents. The said order was challenged by the petitioners by filing an appeal, which was partly allowed vide order dated 20.05.2003 (Annexure P-2) and the matter was remanded to Assistant Collector Grade I, Hoshiarpur. The said order was challenged by respondent No.5-Gurinder Kaur @ Shakti before the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar, who vide order dated 03.06.2005 (Annexure P-3) set-aside the order

Annexure P-2 and the order, Annexure P-1, was upheld. Even the revision filed by the present petitioners was dismissed by the Financial Commissioner vide order dated 21.11.2014 (Annexure P-4). Therefore, by way of present writ petition, the petitioners have challenged aforesaid orders dated 06.03.2002 (Annexure P-1), 03.06.2005 (Annexure P-3) and 21.11.2014 (Annexure P-4).

In view of the fact that the appeal is pending before the competent court against the judgment and decree dated 23.05.2013 (Annexure P-5) titled as Nimrita Naresh Kaur and another Vs. Gurinder Kaur @ Shakti and others passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Dasuya, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to approach the competent authority in case the appellate Court decides the case in favour of the petitioners and dismisses the suit preferred by the private respondents.

In the light of the above and keeping in view the assertions made by counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
