The petitioner filed a writ petition with a prayer for removal of illegal encroachment on the public passage detailed in the writ petition.

The petition was disposed of on 25.7.2018 with direction to official respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass a speaking order.

Section 10 and 12 of the contempt of Courts Act, 1971, was invoked pleading that needful has not been done by the respondents.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Yash Pal Yadav, Collector, District Palwal, filed today in Court, is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that an order Annexure-R1 annexed with the reply was passed and as per the said order, the encroachment from the rasta has been removed. He further submits that even the complainant has given an affidavit of his satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to contradict the said factual aspect.

There is no reason to doubt the stand of respondent.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
