The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 35 dated 15.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 458, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sanour, Patiala, Punjab.

A perusal of the order dated 26.08.2019 shows that learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that the parties have reached an amicable settlement.

Mr. Sumit Kalyan, Advocate had put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and had not denied this statement. Accordingly, interim bail was granted to the petitioner.

Today learned counsel for the complainant is not present.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasmail Singh submits that there is no report of any violation of the conditions of bail.

The petition is accordingly allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on regular bail on his furnishing fresh bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
