Petitioner is an accused in a criminal complaint. He was granted concession of regular bail, however, he jumped the bail on 30.07.2018. Thereafter, the petitioner applied for grant of anticipatory bail by moving the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, who entertained the petition and granted indulgence by directing the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 15 days of the order i.e. 15.10.2018 on which the petitioner shall be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds. Even after the indulgence by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, petitioner did not appear before the learned trial Court. An application for extension of time to surrender was also filed which was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, on 11.06.2019.

In view of the aforesaid fact that inspite of indulgence having been granted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, the petitioner has not chosen to avail the benefit of the indulgence given, therefore, this Court does not find any reason to once again entertain a petition for grant of pre-

arrest bail.

If the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court within one week and applies for bail, the same shall be decided within 3 days.

Disposed of accordingly.
