On 20.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.118 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner contends that although petitioner is attributed to have caused injury with spade which falls within the scope of Section 326 IPC, however, injury is on non-vital part of the body i.e. elbow and the petitioner is also injured as per Annexure P-3, but no cross case has been registered by the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ajay Kamboj, Advocate has put in appearance on

behalf of first informant and has submitted that it is for the police to register a cross case.

In the connected case of co-accused bearing CRM-M-31268- 2019, this Court had issued notice of motion and granted interim protection.

Adjourned to 20.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pardeep Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 20.08.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
