On 20.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 326 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC which were bailable and they after joining investigation, were released on bail by the Investigating Officer. He further submits that offence under Section 326 IPC was subsequently added. He also submits that injury which falls within the scope of Section 326 IPC is attributed to Nand Lal and not to the petitioner herein.

Notice of motion for 23.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarlok Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 20.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
