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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

The contempt petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 04.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.17000 of 2015.

Compliance report filed today in the Court, is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that partial relief has been granted, however, no interest on leave encashment, arrears of pension, death-cum-retirement gratuity etc., is granted.

Learned counsel for the respondents fairly submits that if any such grievance is raised, same would be considered in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

There is no dispute that pay of the petitioner has been refixed and even difference of salary has been paid.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, in case petitioner moves a representation within three weeks from today, the respondents shall take decision on the same within six weeks from its receipt. The representation shall be considered in accordance with law, after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. In case any amount is found due, the respondent shall disburse the same within four weeks thereafter.
