As per pleadings on record, petitioner is an arms dealer and on the strength of an arms dealership licence was running his business under the name and style of Ganpati Gun House.

Counsel submits that the arms dealership licence in favour of the petitioner was valid upto 31.12.2016.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that an application dated 23.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) having been submitted to the District Magistrate, Amritsar for renewal of dealership licence Form Nos. 11, 12 and 14 (now category form No.8 and 9) is still pending and no final decision thereupon has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service. A complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished to him.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the application of

the petitioner at Annexure P-1 is still pending, the same would be processed in accordance with law and as per provisions of the Arms Act 1959 and the rules framed thereunder and a final decision thereupon would be taken expeditious and in any case within a period of three months from today.

Statement made by learned State counsel is accepted.

In the light of the such statement recorded, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
