**ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)**

1. Grievance of the petitioner at the time of filing the writ petition was qua withdrawal of extension in service granted to him on attaining the age of superannuation. Vide interim order dated 21.03.2016, passed by this Court, petitioner was allowed to continue in service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the writ petition, by sheer efflux of time, petitioner

has completed two years of extension in service and superannuated, which renders the prayer of the petitioner infructuous.

3. In the premise, writ petitions are disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

4. It is however, made clear that in case petitioner has any grievance qua retiral benefits, he would be at liberty to approach this Court by filing a fresh petition and disposal of these writ petitions shall not come in his way to seek remedy that may be available under law.
