This petition is directed against the orders passed by the Assistant Collector First Grade, Palwal, District Collector, Palwal and Commissioner, Faridabad vide which application under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 has been allowed and the petitioners were ordered to be evicted from the land in question.

Although counsel for the petitioners has vehemently argued that the impugned orders are patently illegal but he has miserably failed to prove their authorised possession over the land in question as in the past they were recorded as *gair marusi* without payment of rent and lateron, the said land was given to them on lease but the period of lease is not mentioned by the petitioners deliberately so that they may continue over the land in question.

In view thereof, we do not find any error in the impugned orders and, as such, the present petition is hereby dismissed though without any order as to costs.
