The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disbursement of the order dated 6.5.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 11730 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vivek Saini, DAG, Haryana, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to ther merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4- Deputy Commissioner, Ambala Cantt. to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.4.2016 (Annexure P-5 (colly.)) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the

consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

As per order dated 6.5.2019, the respondent had to decide the legal notice dated 22.4.2016 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

It is not forthcoming from the pleadings that certified copy of the order was supplied to the respondent, no proof has been attached. Let copy of the order be supplied to the respondent. There is no doubt that at least now the respondent would realise that the directions of this court were time bound.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
