This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0114 dated 28.07.2019 under Sections 61, 1 and 14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On 20.08.2019 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery of liquor was effected from co-accused Rohan from a vehicle bearing No.PB-07-AW-4699. According to him, the said vehicle does not belong to the petitioner, who has been falsely implicated in this case.

Notice of motion for 06.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the

Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Sadhu Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Sadhu Singh further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.08.2019 is made absolute.
