Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner, in FIR No.0181 dated 11.07.2019, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7 of Immoral Traffic Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

On 20.08.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Contends that present FIR has been registered on account of some differences with the Sarpanch of the Village and no one was arrested on the spot.

Notice of motion for 19.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is

also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Rajpal Singh, has stated that in terms of order dated 20.08.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, order dated 20.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
