The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.723 dated 12.07.2019 under Section 381 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri.

The operative part of the order dated 20.08.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, complainant Rajesh Garg stated that he is running a brass factory and the petitioner was working as Clerk for the last five years. It is further stated that on 02.02.2019, the complainant caught red-handed a person namely Munna along with the petitioner, for committing the theft of brass from the factory. Thereafter, the petitioner and nephew of the complainant had entered into a compromise before the police/CIA, Jagadhri and the petitioner has paid an amount of Rs.2.50 lacs. Learned counsel further submits that FIR has been registered on

12.07.2019 and the police, during the investigation, arrested two persons Gulab and Sarwan and in their disclosure statements, name of the petitioner has surfaced.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 20.08.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Manoj Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 20.08.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
