On 20.8.2019, following order was passed by the Court:

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0077 dated 24.05.2019 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 177 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Nawanshahar (P.S. City SBS Nagar mentioned in the order), District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the complaint and as per the enquiry noticed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Municipal Councilor, Balbir Ram has stated that lady who impersonated as Smt. Vidya was identified by him on the request of the petitioner. He further submits that husband of Smt. Vidya is attesting witness to the alleged sale deed.

Notice of motion for 23.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inspite of his repeated attempts, he could not contact his client Jasvir Kaur.

Be that as it may, once the petitioner prays for concession of

pre arrest bail which is extraordinary relief, the petitioner has to come fairly before the Court and join investigation. Since the petitioner is now not even responding to the communication sent by her counsel, this Court does not feel inclined to extend the interim protection.

Dismissed.
