The petitioners, inter-alia, seek directions to the respondents to count their service rendered before regularization towards grant of pensionary benefits.

In the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4, it is mentioned that all the petitioners except petitioner No.3 have been allotted GPF account numbers under old pension scheme as per the details given in Annexure R-1. So far as petitioner No.3 is concerned, he has died during service and his retiral benefits had already been sanctioned.
