Petitioners seek a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 7.

Both the petitioners are stated to have obtained the age of majority. Petitioner no.2 was married to respondent no.4. It is averred that on account of the harassment and ill treatment meted out to her in the matrimonial home, she has run away and is currently staying with petitioner no.1. Petitioners now apprehend threat to the life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

Without commenting on the relationship/liaison between the petitioners, the instant writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.3 confined to the aspect of danger to their life and liberty.

In the eventuality of any such application being moved, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
