On 18.01.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the State, in the light of the speaking order dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure R-4/1), states that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as according to the said order, the list which was prepared, on the basis of which the elections were to be held, has itself been found to be illegal and has the effect scrapping the same and with a consequence thereof that the election of the office bearers also has been rendered a nullity. This, the counsel states, has resulted in filing of an appeal by the society, which is pending before the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioners prays for a short adjournment to seek instructions.
