In the present writ petition, the claim made by the petitioners is for the grant of interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits to the petitioners.

Notice of motion was issued on 28.09.2018.

Mr. Aman Sharma, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his vakalatnama in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent-Corporation to decide their legal notice which was served upon by the petitioners on 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-3), in respect of the relief which is claimed in the present writ petition. Counsel prays that let the respondent pass a speaking order in a time bound manner while deciding the said

legal notice.

Counsel for the respondent has no objection for the grant of prayer of deciding the legal notice in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 17.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
