Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 18.10.2019, an affidavit of Sh. Harjinder Singh Gill, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Mansa, District Mansa, has been filed, which is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, in the only other case registered against petitioner no.1 (along with others), he was eventually acquitted by granting him the benefit of doubt.

That case was one alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 382, 384, 379, 489A and 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 15, 10, 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

That being so, with the dispute as is subject matter of this petition having been amicably settled between the parties, i.e. the petitioners

and respondent no.2, and a report as regards their statements being recorded in terms of the compromise reached between the parties also having been received from the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa (dated 26.09.2019), stating to the effect that respondent no.2 (complainant, Virender Kumar), as also the petitioners, had appeared before that court and as per statements recorded, the compromise would seem to have been entered into with their free consent; also looking at the commission of crime alleged to have been committed by the petitioners, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.10 dated 20.01.2016, registered against the petitioners at Police Station City-2, Mansa, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 419, 365, 384, 34, 201 and 120-B of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
