This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 31.05.2016 under Sections 364/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station SBS Nagar, District Ludhiana.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court below for bail pending trial. However, it is further submitted that since the petitioners are the members of the family, who have lost their daughter as well, they deserve sympathy atleast in the matter of consideration of the bail pending trial, in this false case which has been created against them by none other than the boy who had enticed their daughter. Even their daughter had committed suicide only on finding that the complainant was already facing number of criminal cases.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to aforesaid.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioners approach the Court below for bail pending trial, their application be decided within a period of two days from the date of filing.
