Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.66 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 411 of Cr.P.C. added later on) at Police Station Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is a delay of two months in registration of the FIR and the investigations are complete and, therefore, further custody of the petitioners is not justified.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kashmiri Lal, has submitted that a mobile phone alongwith sim was recovered from petitioner No.2.

However, on pointed question, it was admitted that both the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are in custody for approximately 2 months and investigations are complete, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
