Petitioners have participated in the selection process for the post of PGT (Mathematics) (Rest of Haryana). They were issued HTET certificate. However, their names were not reflected in the notice dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) for scrutiny of documents.

Result of the petitioners has been produced in Court today. As per this result, petitioner No.1-Rajni Taneja has secured 92 marks in written examination and 15 in viva voce, total 107 marks. Petitioner No.2-Kanvardeep Kaur has got 88 marks in written examination and 14 in viva voce, total 102 marks. Petitioner No.3-Umesh Kumari has secured 92 marks in written examination and 15 marks, total 107 marks. Last candidate in General category has secured 116 marks. Hence, marks obtained by the petitioners are lower than the last candidate selected.
