Grievance of the petitioner is that service record of the petitioner has not been completed owing to which his case for disbursement of proficiency step-up of 8-16 years service as well as the benefit of Assured Career Progression entitled to him on completion of 4-9 years of service, is being kept at abeyance. While on the other hand, officers junior to him have been accorded the said benefit and they have also been confirmed in service, as reflected from notification dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

2. In the premise, the petitioner has been representing the respondents from time to time as reflected from representations dated 24.05.2018, 12.06.2018 and 01.08.2019 respectively, contained at Annexures P-4 to P-6, but none of the representations have been adverted to by the respondents.

Hence, this petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms.Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents, as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 24.05.2018, 12.06.2018 and 01.08.2019 (Annexures P-4 to P-6) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
