Grievance of the petitioner is that he has been wrongly declared medically unfit for selection to the post of Constable (Cook). A perusal of the petition reveals that the selection pertains to the year 2013 and after unsuccessful participation, the petitioner filed the present writ petition impugning his non selection.

2. Having gone through the rival pleadings and after hearing the learned counsel for the respondent- UOI, I am of the view that by the efflux of time, the relief sought by the petitioner is not only rendered incapable of being adjudicated but hit by delay and laches as the selection process is long over and the successful candidates have already joined. On a query posed by the Court, the learned counsel for respondent – UOI submits that record of the selection preserved only for a reasonable period and thereafter the same is destroyed.

3. In the premise, no interference is called for under extra

ordinary writ jurisdiction and petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to seek any other ordinary / alternative remedy if available and if so advised. No order as to costs.
