The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.97 dated 16.06.2019 under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506, 294, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The operative part of the order dated 20.08.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the report dated 15.06.2019 submitted by the complainant/bailiff of the Court, wherein it is nowhere stated that the petitioners created obstacle in the official work, while delivery possession to the decree holders. It is further submitted that since the petitioners have given a complaint to the police officials, present FIR has been registered as a counter-blast to the same.

Notice of motion for 11.09.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 20.08.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Kartar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 20.08.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
