On 20.8.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail
in FIR No.0102 dated 17.07.2019 registered under Sections
379B/34 of the Indian Penal Code at P.S. City-1,
Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that the petitioner has been nominated on the statement of
co-accused. He further submits that the offence alleged
against the petitioner and co-accused is that they tried to
snatch carry bag having a lady purse containing currency
note of Rs.800/- and one lady suit. He further contends that
the petitioner is a young boy, not involved in any other case
of similar nature.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal

Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to the learned counsel for the State during the course of day.

Adjourned to 23.10.2019

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbhazan Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 20.8.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
