Petitioner No.1 prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.52 dated 14.05.2019 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149
IPC (Section 326 and 201 IPC added later) at Police Station Moonak,
District Sangrur.

The petition qua petitioner No.2 already stands dismissed
as withdrawn vide order dated 27.08.2019.

The operative part of the order dated 27.08.2019, vide
which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is
reproduced as under:-

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon
the order dated 06.08.2019 passed in CRM-M No.32775 of
2019, vide which similarly situated co-accused, who were
attributed simple injury, have already been granted the
concession of interim anticipatory bail....”*

Counsel for petitioner No.1 has submitted that, in
pursuance to the order dated 27.08.2019, petitioner No.1 has appeared

before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that petitioner No.1 is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioner No.1 vide order dated 27.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
