The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.6 dated 27.7.2018 at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana (Rural), Punjab under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the parties have amicably resolved their issues and have decided to part ways and a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act seeking dissolution of marriage by a mutual consent had already been filed wherein statements of the parties at the first motion have already been recorded.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh has informed that pursuant to the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 20.8.2019, the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and while also bearing in mind that the parties are stated to have effected a compromise and in fact, a petition under Section 13-B of HMA has already been filed and that the petitioner has already joined investigation, his custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 20.8.2019 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
