Present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos. 1 to 6 to independently and fairly inquire into the representations dated 03.08.2019 and 06.08.2019(Annexure P-4 and P-5) against respondents No.7 to 13 and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their employees from the unscrupulous activities of respondents No. 7 to 13.

The pleadings in the petition and the tone, tenor and the substance of the grievance of the petitioners is regarding the alleged failure of law and order machinery; at the place where the petitioners are claiming to perform a contract awarded to them by the State authorities.

For the above-said grievance, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail their alternate remedies in accordance with law.
