Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.10 dated 09.01.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 201, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines Sonipat, District Sonapat.

As per allegation, certain persons attacked first informant and caused firearm injuries.

It is undisputed that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He is in custody since 10.01.2019. Investigations are complete, challan has been presented and now the case is fixed for framing of the charges. Prosecution intends to examine 31 witnesses.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the fact that the conclusion of the trial is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
