Prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, who claims to be juvenile in FIR No.296, dated 12.08.2018, registered under Sections 148/149/323/324/307/506 IPC, at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

As per the case of the prosecution, the incidents took place in 3 parts. At first instance, a young girl was teased, however when she protested, petitioner along with a co-accused attacked father of the young girl when he was working at the liquor vend and thereafter large group of boys attacked the house of that young girl and caused injuries. One of the injury has been declared to be dangerous to life, attributed to have been caused by the petitioner.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, keeping in view the facts of the case, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial court, his application for bail, if filed, shall be decided within one week.
