TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

As per pleadings on record petitioner No.1 was married to
Hans Raj-respondent No.4 in the year 2010.

Counsel submits that on account of ill-treatment and
harassment meted out by the husband, petitioner No.1 has left her
matrimonial home and is now staying with petitioner No.2-Satnam
Singh.

Instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of
directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of
the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at
the hands of respondent No.4.

Without even commenting on the relationship between the
petitioners as also the liaison between them and without going into
the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it
appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the
petitioners to approach respondent No.3 i.e. the Station House

Officer, Police Station, Mehal Kalan, District Barnala, Punjab
confined to the aspect of threat to their life and liberty. In the
eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent No.3
would be obligated to look into the matter and thereafter to take steps
that he deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law. Ordered
accordingly.
