In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that he should be granted pension w.e.f. 28.02.2006 i.e. when he retired. The claim has been made by the petitioner against the Food Corporation of India. The Food Corporation of India has already filed reply wherein it is submitted that in Food Corporation of India, there is no pension scheme and, therefore, no claim can be made against the Food Corporation of India.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the last two dates when the case was taken up for hearing i.e. 03.04.2017 and 15.10.2018.

It can be very well presumed that the petitioner is not interested to pursue this remedy keeping in view the objections raised by the respondents-FCI.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
