H.S. MADAAN, J.

This revision petition has been filed by Dharam Singh, Charan Singh and LRs of Raghbir Singh, plaintiffs in the civil suit, feeling aggrieved by impugned order dated 01.05.2019, passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Chandigarh, dismissing their application for amendment of the plaint.

I have gone through the impugned order. The same is quite detailed and well reasoned. It does not suffer from any illegality or infirmity, much less apparent on the face of it. The trial Court has observed that when the trial has already commenced and three witnesses have been examined, the plaintiffs could not be permitted to introduce a time barred claim and the proposed amendment could not be said to be directly related to main controversy. It has been noted that the application has been filed just to delay the proceedings. There is no

reason to upset the order by exercising revisional jurisdiction. Finding no merit in the revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
