In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that her case for the grant of benefit in respect of the service rendered by her late husband.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the request of the petitioner was rejected by the Senior Executive Engineer vide order dated 10.08.2017, which action was challenged by the petitioner by filing CWP No.9136 of 2019 and the said writ petition was withdrawn on 04.04.2019 with liberty to approach the higher authorities in the department for the redressal of the grievance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that thereafter, a representation dated 15.04.2019 was submitted by the petitioner to the Additional Superintending Engineer, which representation is not being decided by the respondents without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to respondent No.2 for deciding the representation of the petitioner dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 15.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
