Though this case has been taken up after 4 p.m, that is on the request of both Ld. counsel.

Pursuant to the order dated 22.8.2019, Mr. Surinder Singh, learned State counsel, has filed a status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Ravinder Kumar, DSP, Special Task Force, Haryana, stating therein that the brother of the petitioner, when he reached the IGI Airport, New Delhi, on 26.8.2019, was arrested by the Special Task Force, in connection with FIR no. 326 dated 12.3.2017, registered under the provisions of Sections 302/307/325/472/419/420/120B/34/216 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, Gurugram; and that he was taken on police remand for 7 days. The details of the other cases with regard to the brother of the petitioner (13 in number), have also been given in the affidavit.

It is further stated that the brother of the petitioner is a hardcore

criminal and that “there is no occasion to liquidate the brother of the petitioner i.e. Kaushal in an encounter as alleged in the present petition because so many cases are to be solved and in the absence of the arrest there are no chances to solve those cases.”

The affidavit is taken on record, copies thereof having been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, with the petitioner having been duly subjected to due process of law, I see no reason to continue with this petition.
