[1] At the very outset, learned counsel states that although representation (Annexure P-4) for correction of date of birth of the petitioner was submitted to the respondent-Board but no orders in writing have been passed in respect thereto till date and in any case, no orders had been communicated to the petitioner, till date.

[2] Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) as was forwarded by Annexure P-3 dated 23.01.2018.

[3] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4), in accordance with law.
