Present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation into the matter and to register an FIR against respondent No.4. It is further prayed that directions be issued to respondent No.2 to consider his representation dated 22.5.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Admittedly, the petitioner is stated to have advanced a loan of Rs.10 lakhs to respondent No.4-Harmit Singh, who failed to return the said amount. According to learned counsel for the petitioner he has given a complaint Annexure P-1 for registration of a case.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the representation, this Court does not find any reason for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
