On 26.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.57, dated 26.05.2019, registered under Sections 452/326/506/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not attributed to have caused any injury to the first informant/injured. He further submits that only injury is attributed to Harpal Singh son of Jasbir Singh, petitioner no.3 and not to the petitioners.

Notice of motion for 31.10.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG,

Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kuldip Singh, has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 26.08.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
