The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in Crime Case No. 29 of 2019 dated 20.6.2019 registered under Sections 8, 18, 29, 25, 27A and 60 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act), at Police Station NCB Chandigarh Zonal Unit, UT, Chandigarh.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Even as per the case of the prosecution, nothing was recovered from the petitioner. The alleged recovery is from the vehicle of co-accused of the petitioner. Even the said recovery is less than commercial quantity of the contraband. The petitioner is in custody since 20.6.2019 and there is no other case against the petitioner.

On the other hand, nobody has appeared on behalf of the respondent. It is already 3:00 p.m.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered

to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
