When this petition came up for hearing initially on 27.8.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner had been directed to place on record the MLR in respect of any injuries suffered by the petitioner.

Thereafter by 30.8.2019 the needful not having been done, the matter was adjourned till today, with again no such MLR placed on record.

However, despite the fact that notice of motion was never issued in this petition, ASI Ishru Parshad has come to assist the learned State counsel, who submits that the petitioner has suffered a simple injury on his finger, with the complainant having suffered a grievous injury with a Sickie (*Datar*).

That being so, I see no reason to entertain this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

comment on the merits of the case, which would, naturally, go as per investigation and evidence led in the trial (if it comes to that stage).
