The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 87 dated 18.04.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 295, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR, but no active role is attributed to him and the injuries which have been suffered by the complainant are attributed to other co-accused.

This Court by the order dated 21.08.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer,

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harparshad, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 21.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
